To the greater glory of God and in affectionate memory of Margaret, daughter of Hugh Hill, gent. and wife of Joseph Bellasis, gent., baptised in this church of St Michael at Appleby on 13 Feb 1700, later married on 27 March 1727, died on 21 June, buried near the church of St. Margaret at Long Marton on the sixth day following 1787, aged 86. R.I.P.	
May God be kind to Margaret, steadfast wife, younger daughter by birth of Hugh Hill, of Crackenthorpe, eldest brother by birth of John Hill, Treasurer and Fellow of Queens College in the University of Oxford, learned place, and sister of Benjamin Hill, Fellow of the same College, who entered life on the day of the purification of thr Blessed Virgin Mary, A.D. 1700, married in this church of St. Michael to Joseph, man of integrity, only son and heir of George Bellasis, of Long Marton, by whom she had three sons and five daughters, and breathed her last on 21st day of June A.D. 1787.
